- The Obama administration is debating between two dramatically different schemes for putting Guantanamo Bay detainees on trial.
- Former U.S. President Bill Clinton is on his way to North Korea to try to negotiate the release of two American journalists convicted by the communist state of "grave crimes".
- The popular but overwhelmed "cash for clunkers" program is still rolling, but the White House says the Senate better approve \$2 billion without delay or the big rebates for car buyers could sputter to an end by Friday.
- Bank of America Corp. has agreed to pay a \$33 million penalty to settle government charges that it misled investors about Merrill Lynch's plans to pay bonuses to its executives.
